



## CALIFORNIA STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

### January, 2026

Liquidia Technologies, Inc. (“Liquidia”) is committed to maintaining the highest level of professional and ethical standards in the conduct of its business in every jurisdiction in which it operates. Therefore, Liquidia strongly believes in advancing its business on the basis of its reputation and the quality of its products and services, and not on other factors such as lavish entertainment, lucrative consulting arrangements, improper relationships or transfers of value to government officials or healthcare professionals (HCPs).

To this effect, Liquidia has adopted a robust and comprehensive compliance program (“CCP”) that includes policies and procedures to guide and monitor our interactions with HCPs as required by the April 2003 publication “*Compliance Program Guidance for Pharmaceutical Manufacturers*,” developed by the United States Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General (OIG) and the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America (PhRMA) “*Code on Interactions with Health Care Professionals*”. Within this framework, in order to comply with California’s Health and Safety Codes §§ 119400-119402 Liquidia has established an annual spending limit of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) per HCP in connection with meals and beverages, promotional materials, scientific articles or other educational items or appropriate transfers of value provided to California HCPs.

Liquidia declares, based on its good faith understanding of the California Health and Safety Codes §§ 119400-119402, that as of January 1, 2026, it is in substantial compliance with its CCP and the requirements of California Health and Safety Codes §§ 119400-119402. This declaration is based on Liquidia’s most recent evaluation, which includes consideration of the above annual aggregate limit. This declaration will be updated on an annual basis.
